Dear Sirs,

In reference to the inquiries sent to Fol-Druk Flexo Sp. z.o.o. regarding the compliance of our products/materials/packaging with the requirements of the PPWR (Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation) regulation, we would like to explain that it still has the status of a draft, and the completion of the legislative process is estimated at the turn of 2024/2025. The regulations contained therein will enter into force 20 days after publication in The Official Journal of the European Union, and the application of its requirements will begin 18 months after entry into force, i.e. probably in the second half of 2026.

In addition, we would like to emphasize that the requirements included in the PPWR regarding sustainable development, including, among others, the design and assessment of packaging in terms of its recyclability, the content of recycled materials in plastic packaging and the limitation of the occurrence of potentially hazardous substances, require the issuance of implementing or delegated acts, which will specify the analysis methods and assessment criteria in individual areas.

Our company is constantly monitoring the course of the EU legislative process in the field of PPWR. Regardless of this, we are preparing to implement the solutions introduced in PPWR, and we will inform you about the results of these preparations.

We can assure you that as a member of the Natureef Association, we are constantly improving our competences and making every effort to ensure that our products are created based on the best available knowledge in the field of design, recycling and safety of use for consumers and the environment. We also count on your cooperation and openness in undertaking new projects and implementations that meet the new requirements of the future PPWR regulation.
